2 – President's Report

Season Update -

a) Fees were set and passed at the Financial Meeting on January 15th.

b) Senior teams have been entered for this season - Women's Pennant D and Men's - Metro 1 and Metro 2. Junior team entries do not open until the end of February. I suggest we enter an under 12s full field team and one under 14 pennant team at this stage.

c) Preseason training has begun for the seniors. Numbers are low but will hopefully improve as we continue. Brad Lennie is running the fitness and strength and conditioning based program on Monday evenings. d) Playing tops have been ordered with delivery hopefully in about 5 weeks - this order includes junior and senior playing tops. Tops are now going to be ordered without names and numbers. We will look into a new supplier for the 2024 season and plan so that orders will be placed before the end of this year.

e) A new supplier for socks has been sourced and socks will be ordered through Buffalo Sports in Melbourne. The colour is not an exact match but is close to our existing sock colour. The quality and price is better than socks ordered through XLR8. Delivery will also be 5-6 weeks. The minimum order is for 108 pairs @ \$8.90 +gst/pair. I have placed an order for 108 pairs of socks for our first order.
